Getting Vision Care at Costco? Be Aware!



Costco is only in-network for materials like glasses and contacts!

The eye doctors who work at Costco are independent providers. This means they may or may not be an in-network provider for eye exams. They are "out-of-network" if they are not an in-network provider.



The eye doctor at this Costco location is NOT an in-network provider for eye exams! If a VSP member goes there for an eye exam, they have to pay out of pocket and submit an out-of-network reimbursement claim to VSP.

TIP: Always ask the eye doctor, "Are you an in-network VSP provider?" Not, "Do you take VSP insurance?"

In-Network Labs



Always check if a lab is in-network before getting any tests or blood work. You can call Customer Service at **844-427-8501** or visit **aetna.com** to confirm if a lab is in-network.

Medical Card:

- ☐ Lab





Dental and Vision (employees only)

Dental: There is no ID card for dental! You can go to any dentist. Tell your dental office you have dental benefits with UHH Alaska Plan. They can call Customer Service at **844-427-8501** to verify. **Information on dental is on the back of your Aetna medical card.**

Vision: Your vision benefit is provided by Vision Service Plan (VSP). VSP doesn't issue ID cards for vision. You can view or print your ID card on the VSP portal. Visit www.VSP.com or call 800-877-7195 for more information.
